

#### Graz



- Austria's second-largest city (second only to the capital Vienna)
- ~ 300 000 inhabitants
- important university-city:
   4 universities, 2 universities of applied sciences
   50 000 students

#### Medical University of Graz

**long tradition** (1863 – medical faculty) **young university** (2004)

- ➤ University of Graz was founded in 1585
- one of the oldest universities in Central Europe
- >in **1863: Medical Faculty** was built
- ➤in **1912**, Regional and **University Hospital** was founded
- the largest and most modern hospital in Europe at the time (art nouveau architecture)
- in 2004: Medical University de-merged from the University of Graz and became an independent university






#### **Medical University of Graz – Patient care**



- **➤ University hospital**: ~1,600 beds
- >410,000 outpatients, 88,000 inpatients/year
- ➤ founded: 1912, art nouveau architecture
- still largest (area, approx. 50 buildings) hospital in Europe
- ~ 6,700 employees (people, not full time equivalents; KAGes/provincial government)
- ~ 1,200 employees (federal government physicians and other staff)




